

**ULEN-HITTERDAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
SUPPLY LIST - 2016-2017**

PRESCHOOL (Ms. Crompton): ALL: backpack/school bag large enough to fit folder, 2 two-pocket folders, 2 containers of Clorox Wipes, 10 Elmer's glue sticks, roll of paper towels or pkg. of napkins, box of Kleenex, pkg. BLACK EXPO dry erase markers, box of Ziploc bags (quart or sandwich), extra set of clothes in Ziploc bag (left in backpack), 1 pkg. washable markers, white envelopes (lg. or sm.), box of 5 oz. Dixie cups; 3 YEAR OLD CLASS: 2 small notepads, 1 pkg. small white paper plates, 1 pkg. coffee filters; 4 YEAR OLD CLASS: wide-ruled notebook, pkg. of watercolors, 1 inch binder, small blanket & towel for rest time (small pillow optional) – put in bag & must fit in locker

KINDERGARTEN (Mrs. Groth): 10 Jumbo or 20 Regular Elmer's glue sticks, 2 three-prong folders (one red & one blue), 2 fun folders for communication, pencil box (not a bag, please), pencils (approx. 24), 5 dry erase markers, Crayola crayons (24 ct.), Crayola markers (10 ct. basic colors), 2 large pink erasers, Fiskars blunt tip scissors, watercolor paints (8 pack), GIRLS: Clorox wipes, BOYS: Ziploc sandwich baggies, box of Kleenex to share, backpack, gym shoes, beach towel (resting spot), extra change of clothes (shirt, pants, socks & underwear!) **Donations: Ziploc gallon bags, cotton balls, colored pencils**

FIRST GRADE (Miss Crummy and Mr. Lee): Crayola crayons, Crayola markers, 1 metal Fiskars scissors, 12 pencils, 4 pink erasers, 2 highlighters, 10 glue sticks, 1 bottle of white Elmer's glue, 5 sturdy pocket folders, white 1/2" binder with clear cover (will be used for communication/ homework/take home), 1 spiral notebook, ruler, small plastic pencil box, white board (approximately 9x12), 4 dry erase markers, sock (for white board eraser), gym shoes, paint shirt, box of Kleenex, backpack, ear buds/headphones (recommended but not required.) Last Names A-K - 1 box of Ziploc bags (gallon, quart or snack); Last Names L-Z - 1 container Clorox-type sanitizing wipes. *Donations (greatly appreciated!): hand sanitizer with pump, plastic items (bowls/plates/ spoons/forks.)

SECOND GRADE (Miss Jensen and Miss Forsythe): two-hole crayon & pencil sharpener, 4 black Expo dry erase markers, 24 - #2 pencils (more later), 8 jumbo Elmer's glue sticks, hard shell pencil box, Crayola 10-count washable markers, Crayola 24-count colored pencils, Crayola 24-count crayons, black sock or white board eraser, Westcott kid's scissors, 3-pack Paper Mate pink erasers, 5 two-pocket folders (1 each red, blue, purple, green & your choice), green five-subject wide ruled 170 sheet notebook, black one-subject wide ruled 70 sheet notebook, ruler (standard & metric), 2 highlighters, backpack, gym shoes, large box of Kleenex, box of gallon Ziploc bags, box of quart Ziploc bags
BOYS: bottle of Purell hand sanitizer (to share); GIRLS: container of Clorox wipes (to share)

THIRD GRADE (Mrs. Maesse): 20 pencils (more needed later), 8 count Crayola markers, 5 wide-lined spiral notebooks, 6 pocket folders (purple, red, blue, green, yellow and choice), 2 boxes of Kleenex, 24 count crayons, 6 Elmer's glue sticks, small scissors, 6 black or blue Expo dry erase markers and eraser, erasers, 2 or more highlighters, two 3-ring binders (1 inch,) backpack, gym shoes, hand sanitizer (last names A-L), Lysol wipes (last names M-Z)

FOURTH GRADE (Miss Holm): #2 pencils (no refillable lead pencils), 4 pink pearl erasers, 8 oz. bottle of glue, 24 count crayons (no larger), 8 count Crayola markers, colored pencils (12 or 24 count), 4 highlighters (1 each- blue, yellow, green, and pink), 4 wide-ruled notebooks (*no Trapper Keepers, please*), small pack of sticky notes, scissors, 1 box of Kleenex to share with class, gym shoes, back pack or book bag, and \$5.00 for spelling notebooks, journals, and homework folders; NO pencil boxes please – no room in desks for them.

FIFTH & SIXTH GRADE: 2 boxes of Kleenex, gym shoes, Clorox wipes, \$15 for supplies & assignment book

MATH (Mrs. Holland): 2 notebooks, folder

READING (Mrs. Flaten): notebook
